Setup of Remote Site

Ensure that you have installed the **Diginet Center Software** properly. Also, verify that you have properly configured your site for remote viewing, (*setup static IP Address and router configuration.*) If you are setting up a dial-up connection, ensure that the modem is connected and that your incoming connection has been setup at the site.

Note: No internet connection is necessary if you are using a modem connection

Before getting started double check that you have the site information that you will need to setup your remote connection:

- Site code
- IP Address or Telephone Number (depending on type of connection)
- Site Password

Setup Instructions

1. Double-click on your **Diginet Center** icon.
2. By default, there is no password for your software. You can create a password simply by typing in your new password the first time you load the software.
3. Once the software loads, click on the **Setup** button.
4. When the setup window loads, click on the **Modem** tab.
5. Select **PSTN/ISDN** if you are using a dial-up connection, and select **LAN/ISDN** if you are using DSL, Cable, or have a T-1 connection at the site.
6. Click **OK** to close the setup window.
7. Next, click on the **Connect** button
8. When the connect window loads, you will click on the **Add** button.
9. Now, type in the site information: Site Code, Phone Number or IP Address, and Password (*Default password is 1234*)
10. Click **OK** to close the "Add Connection" window.
11. This will have added your new connection under *Remote Site*, and you simply click on the connection you created and click **Connect**.
12. Assuming that all information was correct, your Center software will now make a connection to your remote site.
13. Once the Center Software connects you will have to select the number of cameras you would like to view and select **Now** from the menu.

*It is recommended that with dial-up accounts you view **1 camera** at a time, and with all others, to viewing **4 cameras** at a time. This is due to video processing capabilities of most home PC's.*
